Baby Puppy

Aged 4 to 6 months on the day of the show

Puppy

Aged 6 months to 12 months on the day of the show

Yearling

Aged 12 months to 24 months on the day of the show

Post Graduate

For dogs which have not won five or more first prizes at Kennel Club Shows (*excluding puppy classes*)

Limit

For dogs which have not won seven or more first prizes at Kennel Club Shows (*excluding puppy classes*)

Open

For dogs of the Dalmatian breed up to seven years old on the day of the show

Special Champion

Restricted to dogs that have won at least three Challenge Certificates, resulting in a Champion title. The winner of this class cannot compete for any Best in Show but will receive a Special Prize. All dogs with a Champion title must enter in the Champion class irrespective of age

Veteran

For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the day of the show

DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
