ON ARRIVAL

Park in the designated car park with ample space between you and the next vehicle, ideally at least 2m

Collect your ring numbers from the table which will be set out alphabetically by your Exhibitor's surname. Do not touch any other envelope except yours

There is no designated exercise area, please use the grassed area outside of the ring deposit the waste in one of the black bags

There will be a separate entrance and exit to the ring with a sanitising station available at each. You must use the correct one and also use the sanitising stations to minimise the risk of any virus transmission. Please do not enter the ring until is called

No prize cards on offer. First place and main rosette awards will be available to collect from the awards table. Please ensure that you only touch the award that you intend to take away

Do not shake hands with the judge or another exhibitor

Finally don't forget your face covering and your own chairs and remember to keep at least 2m away from anyone not in your bubble, even while in the ring
